

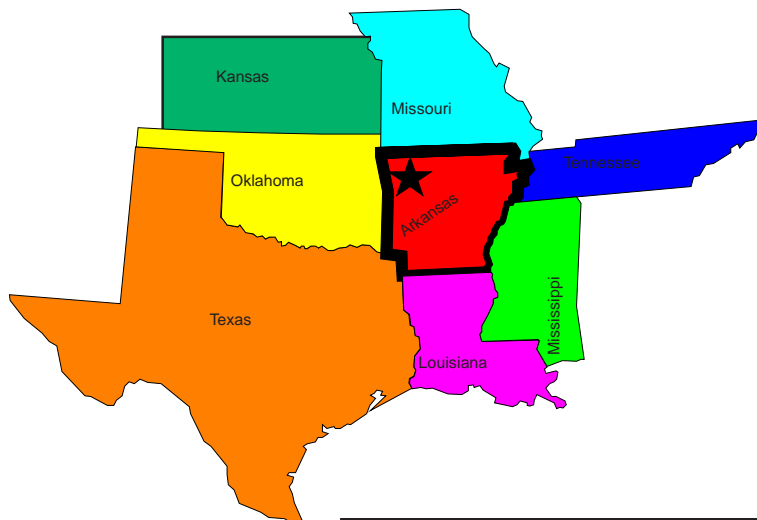


NON-RESIDENT TUITION AWARD

The **University of Arkansas** Non-Resident Tuition Award for entering transfer students pays the out-of-state portion of tuition for qualifying applicants, adjusting the cost of attendance to be the same as paid by in-state students. Transfer students must meet all requirements listed below in order to be eligible. Amount will vary based upon hours enrolled.

How do I qualify?

- ❖ Must transfer from a college or university in Louisiana, Oklahoma, Texas, Mississippi, Kansas, Missouri, or Tennessee.
- ❖ Applicants must have 24.0 or more transferable credit hours with a 3.0 cumulative grade point average.

The Non-Resident Tuition Award is renewable with completion of 24 hours per academic year and a 3.0 cumulative grade point average.

How do I apply?

Request an application for admission to the University of Arkansas or apply online at www.uark.edu. Provide us with all supporting materials, such as your official college transcript and application fee. You will be notified of the Tuition Advantage award upon your admission. We encourage you to apply early!
