Special Students

Deadlines: Fall ~ August 15
Spring ~ January 1

Special Student status is reserved for students who intend to enroll as one of the following:

① **NON-DEGREE SEEKING** — *seeking no degree at the U of A at this time; taking courses only*

Non-degree seeking students should submit the application and fee by the application deadline each semester. Students who have been out of high school for less than three years must also submit a transcript. Non-native English speakers must also submit a TOEFL score.

② **CONCURRENT** — *taking UA courses while still in high school*

Concurrent students should submit the application at least one month prior to the term you wish to enter, application fee, ACT or SAT scores, a letter of intent, and a letter of support from the high school principal. Students with test scores in the 80th percentile and a high school grade point average of 3.5 are eligible. The Faculty Committee on Admissions reviews all applications for concurrent enrollment.

③ **VISITING** — *enrolled in a degree program elsewhere*

Visiting students should submit a completed application, the application fee, and a letter of good standing verifying eligibility to return to the home institution.

Admission as a special student is not available for those who do not meet regular admission requirements. **Special students are not eligible to receive financial aid or scholarships.**

Returning Students

A former student who wishes to return to the University after missing a fall or spring semester (or more) must reapply. To be readmitted, the student must be academically eligible to return and will be readmitted with the academic status of the previous semester of enrollment.

Students enrolled in University correspondence courses during their absence are also required to reapply.

Students who have attended another institution while away from the University will return as transfer students and should meet the same requirements as transfer students, including either a 2.0 grade point average on all college work attempted and/or a 2.0 on all coursework attempted since last attending the University of Arkansas. *Official transcripts of all course work attempted since last attendance at the University must be submitted.*

Your Application Checklist

- Submit your application and fee by the appropriate deadline. (Fee not required for returning students.)
- Send your official transcript(s) to the Office of Admissions. **Non-degree seeking**—none unless you have been out of high school for less than three years, then we'll need your high school transcript. **Concurrent**—submit your official high school transcript. **Visiting**—submit official college transcript or letter of good standing. **Returning students**—if you have attended another institution(s) since your last UA enrollment, please submit the official transcript(s).
- Receive your campus housing application. Apply early! You'll be more likely to receive one of your top choices. Contact Florence Johnson at Residence Life & Dining Services (501-575-3951) if you have questions.
- If you receive a missing credential letter, send the required materials as indicated to the Office of Admissions. You will not be eligible to register for classes until you have been fully admitted.
- Receive admission (or re-admission) notice. Note any conditions of your admission.
- Go to your college and speak with an appropriate advisor. Your advisor will give you an advisement number to use for registration. Non-degree seeking students do not need an advisement number.
- On the appropriate date, call **HOGCALL** to register for classes. Refer to the Schedule of Classes for instructions and steps for registration.
- Receive your Transfer of Credit Evaluation Report (if you had other college work) about two weeks after receiving your admission (or re-admission) notice. Your advisor also receives a copy of this report.
